**Saints in the Church's Calendar;**

St. Benedict, Abbot and Patron of Europe – Thur 11th Born c.480 and died c.547 and was educated in Rome. Turning his back on the worldliness, he retired to live as a hermit in a cave near Subiaco. His fame spread and disciples began to join him, whom he organised into twelve monasteries. He eventually moved to Montecassino, where he founded the famous abbey.

**Children's Corner: In the Gospel Today**

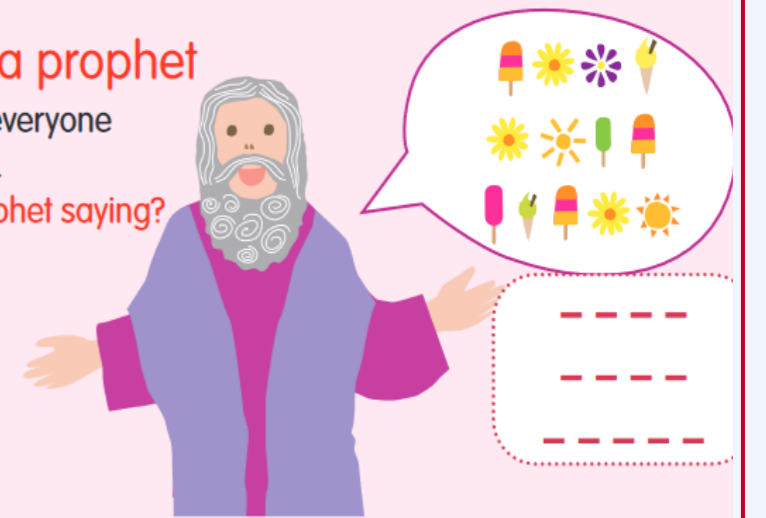
