This in turn allows the parish to accumulate all donations from the tap device, and from family offering/Share/ Common Fund or dues collections. Your information is only required once. Therefore, for all combined donations over €250 the parish can claim the tax back. These new devices will have a poster attached explaining how to donate and why the donor details are important to enable our parish to reclaim the tax back.
